There was a motion by Vice-Mayor Jones with a second by Alderman Officer to approve bid results for the purchase of chemicals for the water, wastewater plants and the swimming pool. The low bids of 150 lb cylinders of Chlorine at \$.50/lb, Sulfur Dioxide at \$.593/lb, and Sodium Hypochloride at \$.768/gal from DPC Chemicals, and Bioxide at \$1.91/gal from Siemens, and Liquid Fluoride at \$3.92/gal, and Sodium Hypochloride at \$1.12gal from Brenntag Chemicals, and Calcium Hypochlorite at \$1.4495/lb, Muriatic Acid 32% at \$.22/lb and Kemira PAX-XL 8/lb at .24/lb from The Dycho Co., Inc.
